Important Information About This Application

Eligibility Requirements:

- **Description of Award** – The Savannah Sports Council will award two \$1,500 scholarships and two \$1,000 scholarships to male and female student athletes enrolled in a Chatham County school, either public or private. The purpose of this scholarship is to award the student that has best demonstrated excellence in the classroom, community, and athletics.
- **Enrollment** - Student must be enrolled and participating in interscholastic athletics at Chatham County School,
- **Senior Status** - Student must be a senior graduating during the 2020-21 school year.

Application Sections & Helpful Hints:

- **Extra-Curricular Form:** Focus on significant participation and leadership experiences, athletic achievements, academic awards and community involvement.
- **One Letter of Recommendation:** Approach coaches, athletic directors, teachers, school administrators, youth group leaders or others in your community and ask one to write a recommendation letter so the judges can learn a little bit more about you. There is a two-page maximum for the letter and only one letter will be accepted from each applicant.

Additional Notes:

- Handwritten applications will NOT be accepted.
- STAPLE the application in this order: application form, and then recommendation. Do NOT use folders, covers or binders. Do not attach certificates, awards or transcripts.
- Complete all parts of the application. Incomplete applications will not be judged.
- Once all documents are complete, please mail originals or scan and email them to the emails at the end of this document.
- Children, Step-Children, and Siblings of Savannah Area Chamber Employees or any Board Members affiliated with the Savannah Area Chamber are not eligible to receive this award.
- Recipient must be enrolled at an institution of higher learning by and during October 1, 2021 which is when the scholarship will be paid.
- Recipient must be able to attend the Georgia Power Sports Award Banquet on May 11, 2021 at 12:00 PM.
