Eligibility Requirements:

- Description of Award The Savannah Sports Council will award scholarships to male and female student athletes enrolled in a Chatham County school, either public or private. The purpose of this scholarship is to award the student that has best demonstrated excellence in the classroom, community, and athletics.
- **Enrollment** Student must be enrolled and participating in interscholastic athletics at a Chatham County School.
- Senior Status Student must be a senior graduating during the 2022-23 school year.

Application Sections & Helpful Hints:

- **Extra-Curricular Form:** Focus on <u>significant</u> participation and leadership experiences, athletic achievements, academic awards and community involvement.
- **One Letter of Recommendation:** Approach coaches, athletic directors, teachers, school administrators, youth group leaders or others in your community and ask one to write a

recommendation letter so the judges can <u>learn a little bit more about you</u>. There is a two-page maximum for the letter and only one letter will be accepted from each applicant.

Additional Notes:

- Hardcopy applications will NOT be accepted, all submissions must be submitted online.
- Complete all parts of the application. Incomplete applications will not be judged.

- Children, Step-Children, and Siblings of Savannah Area Chamber Employees or any Board Members affiliated with the Savannah Area Chamber are not eligible to receive this award.
- Recipient must be enrolled at an institution of higher learning by and during October 1, 2023 which is when the scholarship will be paid.
- Recipient must be able to attend the Georgia Power Sports Award Banquet on Friday, May 5 at 11:30 AM.
